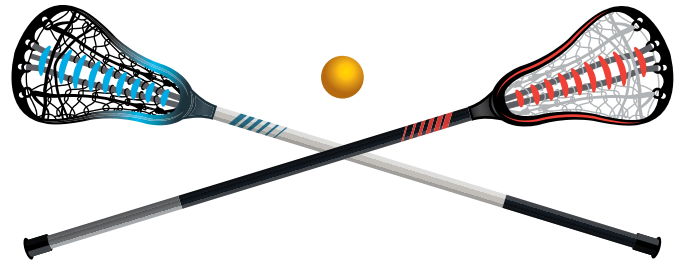


Creator's Game of **LACROSSE**
